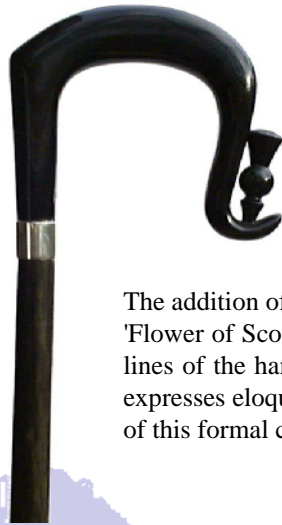

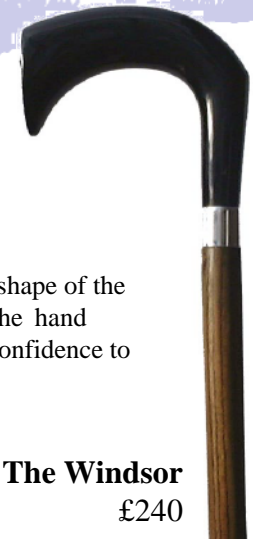
The St Andrew's cane - easy in the hand, with the Scottish thistle shape adding an artistic element to the familiar knob cane.
